

1. What is Innovaccer's HackerCamp'19?

Innovaccer's HackerCamp'19 is an annual hackathon event, aimed at bringing the best coders and programmers from across the nation under a single roof. It is generally a two-day event wherein coders come together to brainstorm on the major problems and present with any solution, software, algorithm, or any application using the concepts from the fields of Artificial Intelligence, Augmented Reality, Internet of Things, and many more, and come with an innovative solution in just 24 hours.

2. When will the event be held?

It will be a 2-day event, running from **14 December 2019, 9:00 AM to 15 December 2019, 9:00 PM.**

3. Where is the venue for the main event?

The venue is Innovaccer Inc., 2nd Floor, Tower 3, Candor Techspace, Sector 62, NOIDA-201309. Locate us on Google Maps [here](#).

4. What is the theme of the event?

HackerCamp'19 is inviting participants to build hacks that can solve any existing problems or have any business use case for one or many of the following fields:

- Engineering and Data Science
- Design and Product Management
- Sales and Marketing
- Recruitment and Employee Benefits
- Infrastructure and DevOps

5. What are the qualifications required to participate in HackerCamp'19?

There are no qualifications as such. If you love coding, then this event is meant for you.

6. Who are eligible to participate in the event?

There are no restrictions for participating in the event. Whether you are a student or a working professional, you are invited to the event.

7. What is the registration procedure for the event?

The event is open to all. Anyone can fill the form at the event's website [here](#). However, you will receive the final invitation to attend the main event from our end after the initial shortlisting of the candidates.

8. What is the last date to register?

10 December, 2019, 11:59 PM IST.

9. Are you allowing walk-ins?

No, we will not be allowing walk-ins. Registration can be done only through the online form available, [here](#).

10. Will there be any shortlisting of the teams?

Yes, there will be an initial shortlisting of teams. We will let you know the result of your submission in the initial shortlisting process via email.

11. Is there any registration fee for the event?

No, there are no registration fees. We invite all to participate in the event.

12. Is this a team-based event?

Yes, HackerCamp'19 is a team-based event. However, you can register individually if you want to register as a "lone-wolf." We will partner you up with other solo participants in the event itself.

13. What is the team size for this event?

You can participate in a team of at most 4 people.

14. I do not have a team, am I eligible for the event?

Absolutely! Lone wolves are also welcomed. If you wish, we will team you up here to help you find your pack.

15. How do I submit my idea and whatever I made for the HackerCamp'19?

It is an on-site event. You are required to present yourself along with your team and gears to prepare the hack in the 2-day duration. You will be required to present it, and it should be working then and there itself.

16. Is there any chance to get an interview call from Innovaccer for the participants?

Yes, Innovaccer might give winners, and interested and deserving candidates a chance to grab an interview.

17. Does the entire idea has to be fully working?

No, the entire idea need not be wholly implemented. However, during the submission, it should be functional enough, so that it can be reviewed by the judges.

18. Since there is no specific technology mentioned, are there any restrictions on using some pre-built libraries?

No, there are no such restrictions.

19. Who will own the IP (Intellectual Property) Rights to the product that I have built?

The developer(s) of the product will have all the rights and own the IP of it. However, all code needs to be open source so that judges can evaluate it.

20. Do I need to give a demo for what I build?

It is your choice. If you want to submit a small presentation or video that demonstrates your submission, go ahead. However, it is not mandatory, but who doesn't love a nice demo! In case you are a winner, you might be invited to give a demo of your application at another event, the details of which will be shared with you well in time.

21. Since a fully developed application will need a robust backend for data storage like SQL, SharePoint, etc. as its database, is it acceptable to present only the prototype?

Yes, it is absolutely fine to submit a prototype. Should you use any database like MySQL, or PostgreSQL, you may submit a database dump along with your prototype submission.

22. Can I work on a project I have previously worked on?

No, you cannot work on a project you have previously worked on. The entire submission has to be made in the event only from scratch. Anyone found to be working on any idea which is previously being worked upon, presented anywhere, patented, or in any way is not built in the premises and duration of Innovaccer's HackerCamp'19 will be disqualified.

23. Do you provide travel reimbursements?

Sadly, we won't be able to reimburse travel costs.

24. Will I get food from the organizers' end?

Yes and only the best! Food, snacks, coffee, and tea (of course!) is on us.

25. Where will I sleep?

Don't worry. We have it covered just like it should be. You'll have mattresses and sleeping space at the venue itself.

However, we know the excitement and the vibe of the event will not let you sleep!

26. What should I carry?

Bring your laptops and Gizmos that might be needed for hacking along with some items for personal care and grooming. Any item that can harm any personnel or the venue in any way is strictly prohibited.
